# FLOWER CARD / VASE

**GRADE**: Primary

Individual

FORMAT: Craft

**OBJECTIVE:** 

## **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- 2, 8.5" x 11" b/w cardstock flower pots (2 versions card or vase)
- 1, 8.5" x 11" b/w cardstock flower petals
- 3 craft sticks for the card
- 3, 6" pieces of posterboard for vase
- 24" ribbon/yarn
- Crayons/markers
- Gluestick

# **CONSTRUCTION:**

# Flower pot card:

- 1. Photocopy the template that will be used.
- 2. Decorate the flower pot/vase.
- 3. Cut out the flower pot/vase on the outside lines. If making the card, fold the card (the fold is on the bottom) together and punch holes on the circles marked.
- 4. Write a message on the front and inside (on the bottom) of the card.

## Flowers - each flower needs 3 petals. Each flower pot/vase can hold 3 flowers.

Each flower will need petals a, b, and c. Color the nine petals on the front and back.

- 1. Cut out each of the petals on the outside lines.
- 2. For petals b and c. fold the petals on the dotted line.
- 3. On each folded petal b, place glue on the back of left side. Attach, at an angle, to petal a.
- 4. One each folded petal c, place glue on the back of the right side. Attach, at an angle, to petal b.
- 5. Repeat for the other 2 flowers.
- 6. Color the 3 craft sticks a stem color, optional.
- 7. Glue the back of each flower to a craft stick.

# To assembly flowers in the flower pot card.

- 1. Open up the card (fold at the bottom). Glue the back of the craft sticks and attach to the top of the card stems down inside the flower pot. Repeat for each flower.
- 2. With the card folded together and starting in the back, place the ribbon in the two sets of holes. Bring the ribbon to the front and tie it in a bow.

# CONSTRUCTION

# Flower pot:

- 1. Photocopy the template that will be used.
- 2.Decorate the flower pot.
- 3.Cut out the flower pot/vase on the outside lines. If making the card, fold the card (the fold is on the bottom) together and punch holes on the circles marked.
- 4. Write a message on the front of the flowerpot.

# Flowers - each flower needs 3 petals. Each flower pot/vase can hold 3 flowers.

Each flower will need petals a, b, and c. Color the nine petals on the front and back.


- 1. Cut out each of the petals on the outside lines.
- 2. For petals b and c, fold the petals on the dotted line.
- 3. On each folded petal b, place glue on the back of left side. Attach, at an angle, to petal a.
- 4. One each folded petal c, place glue on the back of the right side. Attach, at an angle, to petal b.
- 5. Repeat for the other 2 flowers.
- 6. Color the 3 pieces of 6" poster board a stem color, optional.
- 7. Glue the back of each flower to a poster board stem.

# To assembly flowers in the flower pot card.

- 1. Fold (fold at the top) the card so the card 'stands'.
- 2. Cut (or use an exacto knife) open the three slits at the top of the flower pot. Slip the poster board stem into the slit. Repeat for each flower. If the flower leans a bit, bend the poster board stem to keep in place.




